Parties who have access to your personal data (internal and external)

In our company, access to your data is given to parties that need such data to meet our contractual and statutory obligations. Depending on the purpose, this may include:

- **Internal parties:** Customer service, product management, technology, support, bookkeeping, Management Board
- **External parties:** Processors (IT service providers)

Your personal data will be transmitted to third countries outside the European Union or the European Economic Area (BKW AG, service partners of Solare Datensysteme GmbH and IT service providers).

Period of time for which we store your personal data

We will store your data for different periods, depending on the required processing purpose. As a rule, we process your information for the duration of the entire business relationship (from initiation to processing and termination of a contract and until any interest in information on your side has ceased). In addition, we will store your data in compliance and within the framework of statutory record-keeping and documentation obligations, the applicable guarantee, warranty and limitation periods, in the case of legal disputes where data are required as evidence until the end of the dispute.

Disadvantages if you fail to provide your data

If you fail to provide the required data, we will not be in position to conclude a contract with you.

Your rights

- Right of access
- Right to rectification
- Right to erasure
- Right to restriction of processing
- Right to data portability

In regard of our company, if the statutory requirements are met, you are entitled:

- to request information about the specific personal data we process (Art. 15 GDPR);
- to have your data rectified or erased unless our legitimate interests or a legal obligation prevents such processing (Art. 16 and Art. 17 GDPR);
- to restrict the processing of your data (Art. 18 GDPR);
- to assert your right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR);

Note on revocation

You may revoke any consent you may have given with regard to certain processing activities at any time with effect for the future. Such revocation will not affect the previous processing of your data.

Note on objection

Insofar as we process your data on the basis of our legitimate interests, you may object to such processing at any time in accordance with Art. 21 GDPR.
